It is usually used to treat gastric ulcer or reflux esophagitis and to improve gastric mucosal lesions associated w	vith
acute gastritis and acute exacerbation of chronic gastritis.

•For gastric ulcer, duodenal ulcer, anastomotic ulcer, upper gastrointestinal bleeding (due to gastric ulcer, acu	te
stress ulcer, hemorrhagic gastritis), reflux esophagitis, and Zollinger-Ellison syndrome: In general, for adults,	tak
1 tablet (20 mg of the active ingredient) at a time, twice a day, after breakfast, and after dinner or before bedt	ime
You may also take 2 tablets (40 mg) at a time, once a day before bedtime.	
For gastric mucosal lesions (erosion, bleeding, redness, edema) of acute gastritis and acute exacerbation of chr	oni
gastritis: In general, for adults, take 10 mg of the active ingredient at a time, twice a day, after breakfast, and a	afte
dinner or before bedtime. You may also take 20 mg at a time, once a day before bedtime. This preparation cont	tain
20 mg of the active ingredient.	
In any case, the dosage may be adjusted according to the disease, age/symptoms. Strictly follow the instruction	ons.
•Swallow this medicine with saliva after crushing it lightly using your tongue. However, avoid taking this medici	ne
when you are lying down. You can also take this medicine with water or lukewarm water in the same way as th	he
common medicine.	
• If you miss a dose, take the missed dose as soon as possible. However, if it is almost time for the next dose, skip	o th
missed dose and continue your regular dosing schedule. You should never take two doses at one time.	
•If you accidentally take more than your prescribed dose, consult with your doctor or pharmacist.	
•Do not stop taking this medicine unless your doctor instructs you to do so.	
Precautions while taking this medicine	
Possible adverse reactions to this medicine	
The most commonly reported adverse reactions include constipation, rash/eruption, hives (erythema), facial ede	əma
irregular menstruation, gynecomastia and galactorrhea. If any of these symptoms occur, consult with your doctor	or o
pharmacist.	
The symptoms described below are rarely seen as initial symptoms of the adverse reactions indica	ted
in brackets. If any of these symptoms occur, stop taking this medicine and see your doctor immediately.	
•respiratory distress, generalized flushing, hives [shock, anaphylaxis]	
•general malaise, subcutaneous/submucosal bleeding, fever [aplastic anemia, pancytopenia, agranulocytosis,	
hemolytic anemia, decreased platelets]	
•high fever of 38 degrees Celsius or higher, bloodshot eyes, mucosal erosion of the lips/eyes [mucocutaneous oc	cula
syndrome, toxic epidermal necrolysis]	
•general malaise, loss of appetite, yellow discoloration of the skin and the white of eyes [liver dysfunction, jaund	dice
•muscle pain, lassitude, reddish brown urine [rhabdomyolysis]	-
